KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That CYPRESS CREEK VENTURE

hereinafter referred to as "Grantor," (whether one or more), for and in consideration of Dollars (\$_____) to Grantor in hand paid by PEDERNALES ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., of Johnson City, Texas (hereinafter called the "Cooperative") have granted, sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant, sell and convey unto the said Cooperative, an easement and right-of-way for an underground electric distribution system, consisting of a variable number of underground cables and all necessary or desirable appurtenances (including conduits, primary cables, secondary conductors and ground rods underground and concrete pads, ground rods, ground clamps, transformers, cable terminators, cable riser shields, cutouts, and lightning arrestors overground) at or near the location and along the general course now located and staked out by the said Cooperative, through, across and under the following described lands located in Williamson County, Texas, to wit:

All that certain tract of parcel of land being known as Cypress Creek Section 4, as recorded in Williamson County Deed of Records, Vol X Slides 395, 396, 397.

Said easement shall consist of a strip of land ten (10) feet in width being five (5) feet on either side of the centerline, which shall become fixed at the location of buried cables by Pedernales Electric Cooperative, Inc. between the electric meter on the residential structure on each of said lot(s) and the easement area adjacent to the road rights-of-way on each lot, provided that the easement conveyed herein shall not include any area of said strip of land upon which a residence is constructed.

The centerline described above is shown on plat attached hereto, marked EXHIBIT "A", and incorporated herein by reference.

Together with the right of ingress and egress over Grantor's adjacent lands to or from said right-of-way for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, inspecting, patrolling, operating, maintaining and removing said cables and appurtenances; the right to place new or additional cable or cables on said system and to change the sizes thereof; the right to relocate along the same general direction of said system; the right to remove from said lands all trees and parts thereof, or other obstructions, which endanger or may interfere with the efficiency of said system or their appurtenances; and the right to place temporary structures for use in constructing or repairing said system.

Grantor warrants that Grantor is the owner of said property and has the right to execute this easement.

To have and to hold the above described easement and rights unto the Cooperative, its successors and assigns, until said easement and rights shall be relinquished by Cooperative.

Grantor does hereby bind himself, his heirs and legal representatives, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described easement and rights unto Cooperative, its successors and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
